Guest Speaker:

Denis introduced Paul Garry, historian with the City of Greater Geelong, with responsibility for war memorials. Paul Gave an interesting talk covering local and international Australian memorials. He finished with information about our Drysdale cenotaph, and the challenge of adding 11 missing names. Our research needs to be verified by Heritage Victoria before commissioning a specialist who can do the work required. As alternative, we could place all the names in front of the RSL clubrooms unconditionally.

After the meeting, our guest speaker Paul has contacts in the fabrication industry and he will work with David to progress this issue.

"Spirit of Anzac' award - Harry Paterson said the schools he contacted warmly welcomed the idea of a Spirit of Anzac award to an individual selected by the schools, to be presented at the school's speech night.

At a meeting last Thursday (7 August) the committee agreed to move \$5,000 from each of the Drysdale RSL and Women's Auxiliary everyday working accounts to one of our Term Deposits. Sufficient funds remain in those two accounts for current purposes.

All other accounts remain unchanged since George's last report in June.

Wellbeing Report:

Fran Rowell delivered a welfare report. Pam Davis advised members of birthdays for the month of August. Also Joe Gati is in hospital and he has our good wishes.

Remembrance Day: Planning has started for Remembrance Day. The committee needs to nominate an MC for the event as Harry is not available. He will coordinate with City of Greater Geelong for a public event permit. He has asked the Bellarine Secondary College if they would like to nominate one of their students to be guest speaker, and they have agreed. Harry reminded members that Christian College Bellarine had three Year 9 girls as guest speakers for our Anzac Day service and they were terrific. He has requested a RAAF flypast, but that will not be known until a couple of days before the event. Laurie Ward and Andrea Nisbet are arranging some local publicity for Remembrance Day. More to follow.

Golf Day: Geoff Fifer being absent, Harry was able to inform the members that we have secured grant funding from RSL Active to help finance the event. More to follow.

Meeting the President: Denis attended a "Meet the President" at Colac on Wednesday 13 August. Dr Mark Schroffel talked about unity in the RSL and covered the new report on reorganising and governance in RSL Victoria. From the floor, Denis raised the issue of ageing membership and suggested that groups of like minded veterans who might not have considered being members of an existing sRSL sub-branch could instead charter their own new sub-branches within the RSL umbrella.
