Noting our close ties with the school particularly around Anzac Day and Remembrance Day, Denis suggested we participate in the march as an RSL unit.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer reported that we have funds in our general account surplus to our immediate needs, so the committee decided to transfer \$8,000 to a new Term Deposit account, The Women's Auxiliary added \$5,000 to the account as well. Major expenses were \$900 for repairs to our clubroom ceiling and \$300 donation to the Lara RSL Kokoda fund raiser.

She and Heather Joseph have sold badges on behalf of Legacy. She, Denis Hyland and Geoff Zanker attended a Geelong city hall function to recognise the 100th anniversary of Legacy.

General Business

Hub Meeting. Harry Paterson clarified that there is a Regional Hub meeting every three months bringing together representatives from about 10 RSL Sub-branches in the larger Geelong/Bellarine/Surf Coast. Not to be confused with the proposed Veterans and Families Hub promised at the last State election. The Regional Hub meeting did hear about progress with the Vet/Fam Hub, which is now going to be established in what was the ground floor conference room in the Geelong RSL premises, but with a separate entrance. The plan is for the Vet/Fam hub to begin a pilot run from February to May next year before starting a wider operation.

The Regional Hub meeting was attended by Jack Crawford, the Chief Financial Officer for RSL Victoria. He explained the State Branch is registered as a charity and needs to comply with obligations from the Tax Office and the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission in order to retain its charitable status. Therefore compliance with expenditure rules by the subbranches in accordance with By-law 8 is essential. The sub-branches must only expend money from the Patriotic Welfare Account for the relief of "benevolent" veterans. Quizzed on the meaning of "benevolent", he agreed it was not well defined. He added that the funds might be used for the prevention of veterans becoming needy due to social isolation and homelessness as well as poverty. He added that By-law 8 was originally written many years ago and has been added to ad hoc and may no longer be fit for purpose. He promised a re-written version in the near future.

A discussion on these issues was led by Maurie Dean, Bob Atkinson and George Browney.

Remembrance Day Plans. Harry circulated a draft of the public program for Remembrance Day service at the Drysdale cenotaph. We have engaged a bugler Isaac Jamal for Last Post and Rouse, and a guest speaker from Bellarine Secondary College Taylan Black. Our soloist for the national anthems is Lily Petterwood. Harry added that Lily is to appear in a punk rock musical adaption of the Lizzy Borden story at the Old Geelong Goal in January.

"My War" is a gift from Ross Brown. It is a collection of newspaper articles concerning World War II, compiled by Jack Cannon. It is now permanently available for reading in our clubrooms.

Lara RSL Kokoda Challenge. The second annual walk to raise funds for the RSL and PTSD and mental awareness will take place on 25 and 26 October. Lara RSL aims to raise \$100,000 with a two-day 96km walk in the area of the You Yangs, with an overnight camp. The walk is broken up into 9 legs each of about 10 km. Harry has volunteered to walk a couple of the segments and Drysdale RSL has donated \$250 to the cause. Other donations from our members would be most welcome. The link to the challenge is:
